

2012 LCFWDC CHILE CHALLENGE

INSTRUCTIONS

THIS IS A FAMILY ORIENTED EVENT. PLEASE READ ALL OF THE INSTRUCTIONS AND TRAIL RULES. IF YOU CAN NOT ABIDE BY THESE RULES PLEASE DO NOT APPLY.

FORMS-Please complete the entire form for each vehicle. If you want to register as a group, please send all registrants forms in one package. However, we can not guarantee that all members will be assigned the same trails, but we will do our best. Also, very important: **Please print clearly!** Return with payment to: LCFWDC Chile Challenge, P.O. BOX 1344, LAS CRUCES, NM 88004

FEES-Your fee includes 2 tickets for Friday Meal, 2 tickets for Saturday Meal, and the registrations for the trails you select. Additional items such as T-shirts and hats should be selected and paid for on these forms.

CAMPING-Camping from Tuesday night through Saturday are arranged on this form, and paid to LCFWDC. If you will be camping prior to or after the event, you must pay the Southern NM Fairgrounds separately. Please pay your camping fees; otherwise, LCFWDC will have to pay them.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION-Only official forms will be accepted. (Reproductions are OK.) Registration is open to licensed and insured vehicles only. Registrations are accepted by mail or person only—no phone or fax.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY-All cancellations must be received in writing before 5 pm, February 6, 2012 in order to receive a refund of 80%. After February 7th, no refunds will be issued. No refunds will be processed until March 21.

CONFIRMATION CARDS/REGISTRATION PACKETS-Confirmation emails will be sent to all participants whose registration is received by February 1, 2012. All other participants may register or confirm at the fair-grounds during posted times. You will pick up your packet at the fairgrounds registration desk. It will contain your assigned trails, CB channels, staging rows, meal tickets, etc.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT-There are some changes this year concerning required equipment. Your vehicle **must have** tow hooks front and rear, a working fire extinguisher, a first aid kit, seat belts, insurance, and registration.

RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT-There are some recommended items that you we request you have in your vehicle this year. They are a 40 channel CB, and a spill kit, and a roll bar appropriate for the trails you will be running.

SECURITY-There is no security on the fairgrounds premises or on the trails. Take proper precautions to secure your items from theft.

TRAIL RULES

ALCOHOL / ILLEGAL SUBSTANCE POLICY-Absolutely no alcohol or illegal substances are allowed on trail rides. If any use is spotted you will be required to leave without a refund.

TRAIL LEADERS / TAIL GUNNERS-There will be assigned trail leaders and tail gunners for each trip. The ultimate authority on the trail is the trail leader. Their job is to ensure that everyone has a safe and fun four wheeling experience. Depending on circumstances, there may be break-downs within the trail. The trail leader will discuss the situation with the vehicle owners to decide the best course of action for repair / removal of the vehicle. The BLM does not want any vehicles left on the trails overnight.

VEHICLE TECH INSPECTIONS-Each vehicle will be inspected to ensure that it meets the minimum requirements for the hardest trail requested. It must have the required safety equipment. If your vehicle does not meet trail requirements your selected trails may be reassigned. Please see trail requirements (on www.chilechallenge.org website) for more information.

ROGUE TRAIL RUNS-All trail rides must be official Chile Challenge trail rides. Unauthorized running of trails that are not scheduled with and lead by a LCFWDC designated trail leader are prohibited. If you choose to participate in unauthorized trail rides you may forfeit your entry fee and be asked to leave the event. You may also forfeit the ability to participate in future events. Do not run trails that are not scheduled. Unscheduled or rogue trail runs will not be overlooked.

VEHICLE WASH-All vehicles will undergo a mandatory wash down. This is intended to stop the transfer of invasive vegetative species and noxious weeds. If your vehicle is clean; it will still be washed. A power washer will be provided for your use. Please do not waste your money at the car wash. This must be done on site at registration.

USE OF BYPASS ROUTES-The use of unauthorized bypass routes, or "braids", is strictly prohibited. Please stay on the designated trail routes during all trail runs before, during, and after the Chile Challenge. Tread Lightly.

VEHICLE REGISTRATION AND INSURANCE-All vehicles must be registered and insured four-wheel drives. Please bring proof of liability insurance to the event. Neither the LCFWDC nor BLM are responsible for accidents, damage, or injury to persons or vehicles. All drivers must be at least 18 years old and are responsible for the occupants of that vehicle. All occupants must be registered and sign a hold harmless waiver.

TREAD LIGHTLY-Drive responsibly to protect the environment and drive only where motorized vehicles are permitted. All participants must abide by BLM rules and regulations. Do not take items from historic sites. Leave history for all to enjoy. Please exercise Tread Lightly principles.

TRAIL ETIQUETTE-The Chile Challenge is held in conjunction with the BLM. Please be courteous, respectful, and helpful to all BLM law enforcement, staff, and volunteers. This includes any Dona Ana County Sheriff Deputies, Mounted Patrol, Event Staff, and Search and Rescue volunteers.

THE BOTTOM LINE-Submittal of this registration is acknowledgement that you have read and agree to all of the Chile Challenge Guidelines and Trail Rules. Failure to follow these instructions may result in being asked to leave the event without a refund.
